Congratulations. As an esteemed participant and standout student of FSU's IT Project Management class, you have been selected for the following exciting task!

\$YOUR_PERSON will be on a flight arriving into Tallahassee Regional Airport, 9:00 am. Saturday, June 4, 2015. You have been selected to escort and accompany \$YOUR_PERSON for the duration of that day. Since they are well known figure in the realm of \$THEIR_FIELD, they will be giving a large public \$WHATEVER_THEY_DO at the Leon County Civic Center at 2:00 pm. The plan of details of this public function have already been taken care of. However, you will be responsible for the following:

- Picking up \$YOUR_PERSON at the airport
- -\$YOUR_PERSON will need a bit of downtime; so you'll get them checked in at a hotel and will give her/him at least 2 hours to rest.

Goals are abstract, Objectives are concrete. Consider using SMART Objectives

Specific, Measurable, Attainable/Achievable, Realistic, and Timebound

This is a project plan, wherein you are plotting out everything that needs to happen for the day to be a success. If your project plan starts on June 13, you're gonna have a bad time.

Think contingencies: Flights can be delayed, venues can be canceled, and so forth.
